Who Should Complete the Course?

Production operatives

Course context

Learners must do the following mandatory modules:

- Complying with Statutory Regulations and Organisational Safety Requirements

Plus one of:

- Promoting effective working relationships, or;
- Contributing to effective team working

Learners then choose three support units, which include:

- Preparing for manufacturing operations
- Concluding manufacturing operations
- Receiving and checking incoming materials
- Controlling manufacturing operations
- Contributing to effectiveness in the work place

Plus a job-specific unit, examples of which are:

- Producing products by assembly operations
- Producing formed products
- Finishing products
- Manufacturing products using combined manufacturing operations
- Analysing the results of inspection and confirming quality of production

It may be possible to offer additional support to candidates on certain units. Our consultants will work with you to establish your requirements and offer you the best pathway.
